DAS Fleet EMS Objectives and Targets

<u>DEFINITIONS</u> Environmental Management System (EMS) means a structured management system

integrated within the organization to achieve and demonstrate sound environmental

performance by controlling the impacts of their activities.

Statewide Fleet Administration (DAS Fleet) means the employees of who perform the

duties and responsibilities of managing the vehicles owned by the State of Oregon,

DAS Fleet, and used by the employees of the public body.

GUIDELINES:

- I. The employees of the Department of Administrative Services, Statewide Fleet Administration, recognize their responsibility to the environment and future generations. Through the EMS, they pledge to develop and implement policies and programs that will assist Oregon in meeting the goals set forth in the Governor's Executive Order on Sustainability EO 06-02, and any associated rules and statutes.
- **II.** Superior environmental performance is achieved through a commitment to pollution prevention and waste reduction, establishment and review of objectives and targets, training and awareness, and continual assessment and improvement.
- **III.** The Environmental Management System ensures that activities, products, and services exceed all applicable rules, regulations, and other requirements.
