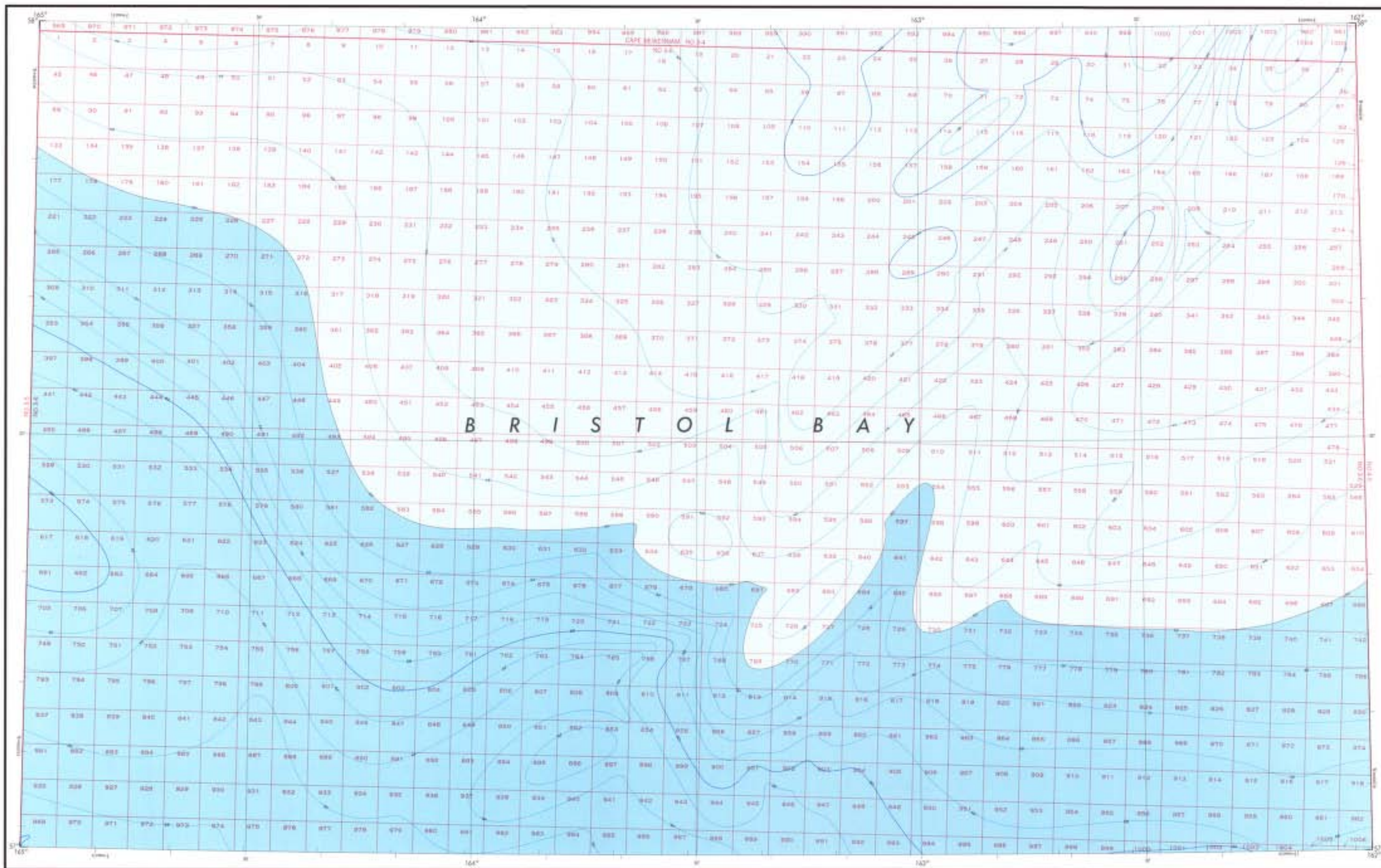

BRISTOL BAY NORTH

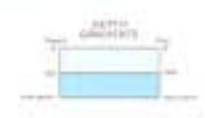
