- 2 grants for a specific purpose but the recipients are not specifically
  named in the appropriation act. The Report language may shed
  additional light however; these should be treated as soft earmarks since
  no specific recipient is named.)
- 2 new financial assistance programs.
- Authorization/financing for 3 FCRP (Southeast Alaska purse seine fishery; Federal Gulf of Mexico Reef Fish FMP, the non-pollock groundfish fishery in the BSAL)

## Comments:

- 1. A direct payment of \$10,000,000 to the Alaska Fisheries Marketing Board.
- 2. Sec. 206 makes \$1,000,000 available for the "Wild American Shrimp Initiative". This is an ongoing activity funded as a grant to the Wild American Shrimp Alliance. The use of the term "initiative" and not listing the specific organization should be interpreted as the intent to make a grant.
- 3. Sec. 206 also makes available \$1,000,000 for the Gulf Oyster Industry Education Program. No specific recipient is listed and the description implies a grant. I will need to compare this language with the report language to determine whether this is a congressionally-identified award.

TITLE II—DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND RELATED **AGENCIES** GENERAL PROVISIONS-DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE SEC. 206. Of the amount available from the fund entitled "Promote and Develop Fishery Products and Research Pertaining to American Fisheries", \$10,000,000 shall be provided to the Alaska Fisheries Marketing Board, \$1,000,000 shall be available for the "Wild American Shrimp Initiative", and \$1,000,000 shall be available for the Gulf Oyster Industry Education Program: Provided, That: (1) the Alaska Fisheries Marketing Board (hereinafter "the Board'') shall be a nonprofit organization and not an agency or establishment of the United States; (2) the Secretary may appoint, assign, or otherwise designate as Executive Director an employee of the Department of Commerce, who may serve in an official capacity in such position, with or without reimbursement, and such appointment or assignment shall be without interruption or
