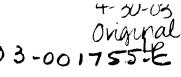

This responds to the nomination of 12 members to the Alaska Fisheries Marketing Board (Board) by Alaska Governor Frank Murkowski in a letter to you dated June 6, 2003, and to which you responded that you have initiated the process of review.

#### **Background**

Section 209 of the Department of Commerce and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2003. (Title II, Division B, Pub.L. 108-7 (Feb. 20, 2003)), makes \$10 million available to the Board "to develop an Alaska seafood marketing program." The section reads further as follows:

Such amount shall be made available as a direct lump sum payment to the Alaska Fisheries Marketing Board (hereinaster "Board") which is hereby established to award grants to market, develop, and promote Alaska seafood and improve related technology and transportation with emphasis on wild salmon, of which 20 percent shall be transferred to the Alaska Scafood Marketing Institute. The Board shall be appointed by the Secretary and administered by an Executive Director to be appointed by the Secretary. The Board shall submit an annual report to the Secretary detailing the expenditures of the Board.

Emphasis added. The funds identified by § 209 were appropriated from the "the amount available from the fund entitled 'Promote and Develop Fishery Products and Research Pertaining to American Fisheries." That account is identified in the Treasury as a NOAA account (13X5139) with 15 U.S.C. § 713c-3 (also referred to as the Saltonstall-Kennedy Act) as its statutory basis.

#### Discussion

The legislation does not oblige you to assert any supervision or control over the Board other than to appoint members and an Executive Director and review the Board's Annual Report to you that is required by statute.

As noted in the draft letter to Govenor Murkowski, the individuals being appointed to the board represent a broad cross-section of the Alaska Seafood industry and are well qualified to promote the marketability of Alaska scafood and seafood products. During discussions with Senator

Stevens' staff, it was determined that the number of Board members appointed to the Board should total no more than 11 members, each serving a two year term.

Appointment of an Executive Director is being postponed pending the passage of additional legislative language to provide for the appointment of a Federal employee to such a position. Senator Stevens has proposed that a current employee of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, William Hines, be appointed to that position. However, a Federal conflict of interest statute bars an employee from serving in a fiduciary relationship with a non-Federal entity absent specific statutory authority. Once legislative authorization has been obtained, I will propose the appointment of Mr. Hines to the Executive Director position. Until then, I have assigned him as part of his NOAA duties to provide advice and assistance to the Board.

### Conclusion

I recommend the appointment of the eleven individuals to the Board. NOAA will begin the process of providing the \$10 million appropriation to the Board in a direct authorized grant after the appointment of the Board members.
