LEDS Website Article – Motorcycle/Moped Temporary Registration

DMV received a request from dealers and motorcycle/moped riders for a smaller motorcycle/moped temporary registration permit designed to mount on the rear license plate frame. Currently DMV and dealers issue a full size temporary registration permit for all vehicles including motorcycles/mopeds. Motorcycle/moped owners are unable to display the temporary registration on the windshield or on the rear of the vehicle since the permits are not weatherproof.

DMV has designed a motorcycle/moped temporary registration permit to fit in the motorcycle/moped license plate frame. The new permit is made of water resistant material and contains an inventory number (MT000000), effective date, expiration date, counter date and dealer number. Customers will receive and carry a paper copy of the permit that also contains the owner and vehicle information in addition to the information listed on the permit. DMV and dealers will begin issuing the new permits starting August 15, 2007.

DMV trip permits for motorcycle/mopeds will continue to be the standard size. DMV would appreciate any information from law enforcement regarding problems associated with the new smaller motorcycle/moped temporary registration permit. Contact DMV Vehicle Programs Form Coordinator at 503-945-0866.
