## **RULE SUMMARY**

**OAR Chapter 440-045-0020, 440-045-0025**: Pursuant to ORS 656.612, the Director shall adopt by rule the assessment to be imposed and collected from insurers, self-insured employers and self-insured employer groups, based on workers' compensation direct earned premium, in an amount sufficient to meet the expenses of the department in carrying out its duties under ORS Chapter 656, ORS Chapter 654 and the Insurance Code. The assessment rate is established annually. These rules establish the assessment rate for calendar year 2007.
