MOTION OF MERCK-MEDCO MANAGED CARE, L.L.C. FOR EXTENSION OF TIME IN WHICH TO FILE MOTION FOR IN CAMERA TREATMENT OF PROPOSED TRIAL EXHIBITS

Third party Merck-Medco Managed Care, L.L.C. ("Merck-Medco"), hereby respectfully requests an extension of time in which to file a motion for *in camera* treatment of certain trial exhibits to be used by Upsher-Smith Laboratories, Inc. ("Upsher-Smith"), in this proceeding. In support of this motion, Merck-Medco states as follows:

- The Third Revised Scheduling Order sets December 27, 2001 as the deadline for filing motions for in camera treatment of proposed trial exhibits.
- Merck-Medco received Upsher-Smith's proposed trial exhibit list or at least that
 portion containing documents previously produced by Merck-Medco pursuant to
 subpoena on December 26, 2001.
- Federal Trade Commission Rule of Practice 3.45(b) provides that a third party should have ten (10) days notice of the proposed use of such material in which to

- file a motion for *in camera* treatment. Under Rule 3.45(b), Merck-Medco's motion is due to be filed on Monday, January 7, 2002, as the tenth day, January 5, falls on a weekend.
- 4. There are several documents on Upsher-Smith's proposed exhibit list for which

 Merck-Medco may seek in camera treatment. Most of these were previously

 produced pursuant to subpoens bearing the designation, "RESTRICED

 CONFIDENTIAL -ATTORNEY EYES ONLY."
- 5. The documents in question originate from different areas of Merck-Medeo and, thus, there are several individuals who need to be consulted before we may determine whether to make a motion for *in camera* treatment for some or all of the documents in question. Unfortunately, because Merck-Medeo did not receive Upsher-Smith's proposed exhibit list until December 26, 2001, in the middle of a popular vacation time, some of those individuals were and are currently on vacation. In addition, those returning on January 2, 2002, may not be immediately available to address the issues raised by Upsher-Smith's proposed exhibit list. Thus, there will not be sufficient time to discuss the issues, prepare the motion, and have it filed with the Commission by January 7, 2002.
- 6. Accordingly, Merck-Medco requests an extension of four (4) days, to January 11,

2002, in which to file a motion for *in camera* treatment of Upsher-Smith's proposed exhibits. A proposed form of Order is attached.
