ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR MORE DEFINITE STATEMENT

On July 5, 2002, Respondent Rambus, Inc. ("Rambus") filed a motion for a more definite statement. The Commission's Rules of Practice require the Commission's complaint to contain a clear and concise factual statement sufficient to inform respondent with reasonable definiteness of the type of acts or practices alleged to be in violation of the law. 16 C.F.R. § 3.11(b). The Complaint in this matter, filed on June 18, 2002, meets this requirement.

Respondent has not made a reasonable showing that it cannot frame a responsive answer based on the allegations contained in the complaint. See 16 C.F.R. § 3.11(c). Accordingly, Respondent's motion for a more definite statement is DENIED.
