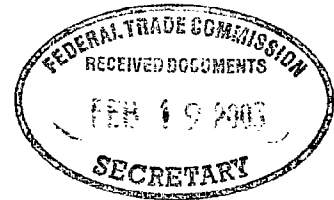

**JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF REVISED SCHEDULING ORDER
AND REQUEST FOR TELEPHONIC SCHEDULING CONFERENCE**

Complaint Counsel and Counsel representing Respondent Rambus Inc. hereby jointly request that Your Honor approve the proposed Fourth Revised Scheduling Order attached to this motion. In addition, counsel jointly request an opportunity to speak with Your Honor, through a telephonic conference, about scheduling-related issues.

We have jointly moved at this time for additional changes to the pre-hearing schedule for several reasons. First of all, difficulties associated with recent winter weather in the Washington area have led to a need for agreed-upon extensions in certain near-term deadlines, such as the deadline for filing motions for summary decision. Weather-related difficulties have also caused certain depositions to be postponed. Independent of this, the parties have already been experiencing difficulty in scheduling the completion of non-expert depositions by the February 24 cut-off date specified in the Third Revised Scheduling Order. By agreement, the parties have already scheduled several fact depositions to take place after that date, and the cancellation of depositions this week will only compound the need to schedule some fact depositions after the February 24 cut-off date. Extensions in the dates for summary decision briefing and the


completion of fact depositions inevitably create other scheduling pressures and difficulties. In particular, deadlines for the completion of expert discovery and exhibit lists are looming. These deadlines have become increasingly difficult to meet as other deadlines have needed to be extended. The parties' agreed-upon proposal for relieving these scheduling concerns involves extending certain dates and deadlines by one week, others by two weeks, and still others by three weeks. Under our agreed scheduling proposal, the hearing start date would move by three weeks, from April 9 to April 30.

In addition to requesting that Your Honor enter the revised schedule attached hereto, we are also at this time requesting a telephonic scheduling conference. We are requesting such a conference in part for the purpose of inquiring about the potential reassignment of this case to a different Administrative Law Judge, primarily with an interest in learning when such a transition is likely to occur, if at all, and if so, what if any impact this might have on the pre-hearing schedule in this case. If such a transition is to occur, our mutual hope is that the modest scheduling extensions proposed by this motion will help to facilitate such a transition.

For the reasons stated herein, we respectfully request that Your Honor enter the proposed Fourth Revised Scheduling Order, and that Your Honor advise the parties as to the preferred date and time on which to hold a telephonic scheduling conference.

Counsel for Rambus has consented to the filing of this joint motion by Complaint Counsel, and to Complaint Counsel's representation that Rambus concurs in all respects with the motion and with the proposed order attached hereto.


