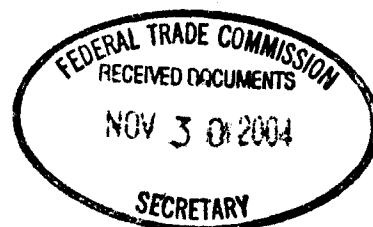



**ORDER ON RESPONDENTS' UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF  
TIME TO PROVIDE EXPERT REPORT OF DANIEL B. MOWREY, PH.D. AND  
FOR COMPLAINT COUNSEL TO IDENTIFY REBUTTAL EXPERT AND  
PROVIDE REBUTTAL EXPERT REPORT**

On November 29, 2004, Respondents filed an unopposed motion seeking to extend the deadline for Daniel B. Mowrey, Ph.D., to submit his expert report. Respondents seek a four day extension from November 29, 2004 to December 3, 2004 based on the serious health problems of Mowrey's wife. Respondents represent that Complaint Counsel does not object to the extension but that Complaint Counsel requests a four day extension to December 17, 2004 to submit their rebuttal report rebutting Mowrey's expert report. Based on the agreement of the parties and good cause, the motion is **GRANTED**.
