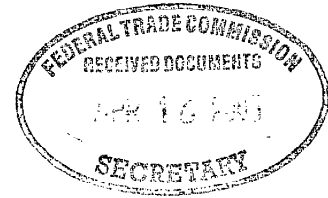

**ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S MOTION  
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SUBPOENAS *DUCES TECUM***

On April 7, 2003, pursuant to Rule 3.36 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, Respondent Union Oil Company of California ("Unocal") filed two motions for orders authorizing the Secretary of the Commission to issue a subpoena *duces tecum* to the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") and to the California Air Resources Board ("CARB"). On April 11, 2003, Complaint Counsel filed a response to Unocal's motions, seeking a stay on a decision on Unocal's motions for a period of ten days. Unocal filed an opposition to Complaint Counsel's response on April 15, 2003. On April 16, 2003, Complaint Counsel withdrew its request for a stay.

Respondent's motions are GRANTED.

Pursuant to Rule 3.34, in the event that the EPA or CARB seek to limit or quash the subpoenas, the EPA and CARB shall have the earlier of ten days after service of the subpoena or the time for compliance therewith to file any such motion. 16 C.F.R. § 3.34(c).

Respondent shall serve a copy of this order on the EPA and CARB at the time it serves the subpoenas. 16 C.F.R. § 3.36(c).
