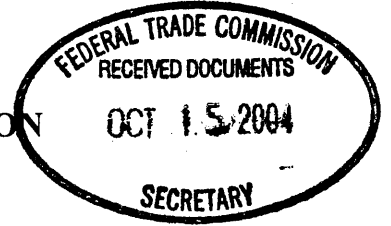

MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Respondents Telebrands Corporation, TV Savings, LLC and Ajit Khubani ("Respondents") hereby move the Commission for an extension of time for the filing of various briefs in this matter. Complaint Counsel have authorized us to state that they have no objection to the granting of the relief requested in this motion.

The service of the Initial Decision in this matter has resulted in the initial Appeal Brief by Respondents being due on Monday, October 25, 2004. Because Complaint Counsel has also appealed in this matter, their Brief, which would include both their initial Appeal Brief and the Answering Brief, would currently be due on Wednesday, November 24, the day before Thanksgiving. Respondents' Reply Brief would be due on


Monday, December 6, 2004 and Respondents' Answering Brief would then be due on Monday, December 27, 2004 (because of the Christmas holiday). Complaint Counsel's Reply Brief would be due on Thursday, January 6, 2005 (again, excluding the New Year's holiday). Because of long-standing family commitments and travel plans, the proximity of the briefing schedule to the Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Years holidays would work substantial inconvenience and hardship on some of the counsel involved in this matter.

Consequently, Respondents respectfully request that the following revised schedule be ordered for briefs in this matter:

Respondents' Initial Brief	November 3, 2004
Complaint Counsel's Answering Brief and Appeal Brief	December 7, 2004
Respondents' Reply Brief	December 16, 2004
Respondents' Answering Brief	January 6, 2005
Complaint Counsel's Reply Brief	January 18, 2005

In summary, the last brief, under the proposed schedule, would be filed only approximately two weeks after the last brief would be filed under the existing schedule.


