DECLARATION OF JOSEPH ARANGO IN SUPPORT OF THIRD-PARTY BLUE CROSS BLUE SHIELD OF ILLINOIS' MOTION FOR IN CAMERA TREATMENT OF PROPOSED TRIAL EXHIBITS

- I, Joseph Arango, declare as follows:
- 1. I am Senior Director of Provider Contracting and Strategy of Blue Cross Blue Shield of Illinois ("BCBSI"). I have been employed at BCBSI since 1982. I have been a manager in the contracting area since 1990 and have been in my current position since 1998. In that capacity, I am familiar with the process by which BCBSI negotiates its contracts with hospitals and the confidentiality afforded documents prepared in relation to those efforts.
- 2. True and correct copies of the documents and an accurate list of the data files for which BCBSI seek *in camera* treatment are attached as Exhibits 1-4.
- 3. I have reviewed the documents (Exhibits 1-4) for which BCBSI seek *in camera* treatment. As Senior Director of Provider Contracting and Strategy, I am familiar with the type of information contained in the attached documents. I am also generally familiar with the confidentiality protection afforded this type of information by BCBSI. Based upon my review of these documents, my knowledge of BCBSI's business, and my familiarity with the

confidentiality protection that BCBSI afford information of this type, it is my belief that public disclosure of these documents and data files, or the information contained in them, would cause serious competitive injury to BCBSI.

- 5. Each of these documents reflect current hospital service agreements and amendments to those agreements.
- 6. These documents contain heavily negotiated and commercially sensitive pricing and contracting terms between BCBSI and individual hospitals that are competitively sensitive. The structure, terms and scope of these agreements are the product of significant investment over many years by BCBSI, and are the key to its operations.
- 7. Contract negotiations can span months and involved hundreds of employee hours, including negotiation, strategic thinking, actuarial analysis, financial modeling and legal and regulatory review and drafting.
- 8. BCBSI's efforts in this regard have allowed it to gain a competitive advantage in the marketplace and better service its customers.
 - 9. BCBSI has made great effort to protect the confidential nature of these

documents. Internal distribution of these documents is limited to those who deal with the specific providers in negotiating the contract terms, their direct supervisors, and the BCBSI legal department. Other than the hospitals that are parties to these respective agreements, BCBSI does not share its agreements with any third-parties.

- 10. The public disclosure of these documents would cause severe competitive injury to BCBSI.
- 11. Exhibit 2 consists of correspondence between BCBSI and various hospitals regarding the terms at which BCBSI or the hospital would or should contract for healthcare services.

12. These seven letters reflect the terms upon which agreements were reached, as well

as proposed terms under consideration. BCBSI-ENH 006517-6523 contains an internal ENH analysis outlining the pricing terms and rate increases offered by BCBSI.

- 13. This information is extremely valuable and competitively sensitive. These letters reflect the negotiations that take place between BCBSI and its hospital clients and contain proprietary and competitively sensitive terms and proposals regarding reimbursement of hospital healthcare claims.
- 14. Internal circulation of these letters is generally limited to the employee(s) conducting the negotiations. These letters are not shared with competitors or other hospitals.
- 15. The public disclosure of this information would greatly undermine BCBSI's negotiating ability and competitive standing in future contract negotiations.
- 16. Exhibit 3 consists of documents containing internal pricing analysis, contract negotiation analysis, and/or management strategy.

- 17. These five documents contain competitively sensitive and highly confidential information.
- 18. BCBSI's pricing and contract negotiation analysis (BCBSI 20516, 8648 and 01581) not only reflects BCBSI's determinations about what prices to charge in general, it also reflects certain pricing and contracting terms that are still in effect.
- 19. BCBSI's internal email communications regarding the Company's conflict with one of its customers (BCBSI-ENH 05228-30 and BCBSI-ENH 005564-85) describe BCBSI's management strategies for responding to the dispute, including planned responses and communications relating to possible events.
- 20. These documents go to the heart of BCBSI's business planning and are among the most confidential material that BCBSI maintains.
- 21. Except as compelled by the Civil Investigative Demand, these documents were never disclosed externally by BCBSI. Internal circulation was limited only to those involved in strategic planning for the Company. If publicly disclosed, hospitals would use it against BCBSI in future contract negotiations and other payors would use it in designing their own competitive strategies to BCBSI's disadvantage. Disclosure of these materials would cause serious injury to BCBSI.

22. Exhibit 4 consists of a list of computer data files containing claim and reimbursement data by patient, claim and hospital from 1998-2003. This data is highly confidential and proprietary to BCBSI, the hospitals with which BCBSI contracts, and BCBSI covered patients.

- 23. Under no circumstances would BCBSI make these data files public. BCBSI limits access to the data to a very small number of employees. Even those responsible for negotiating hospitals contracts only see the data on an aggregated basis after it has been used in certain financial models.
- 24. This compiled dataset is not available from any other source. It could not be duplicated by hospitals or other competing payors.

- 25. Disclosure of this computer data would cause significant privacy concerns for BCBSI covered patients and competitive concerns for BCBSI's business. Although the identity of individual patients was masked in the data set produced, the data set contains information that could be used by motivated third parties to uncover patient identifying information. Thus, disclosure of the data could jeopardize the privacy interests of individuals whose claims, payments and reimbursement records are reflected in the database.
- 26. Release of the data would allow BCBSI competitors to construct a detailed and accurate financial model of BCBSI's business and use it to BCBSI's detriment. Both BCBSI covered patients and BCBSI will suffer serious injury if these data files are made public.
