Description of content:</b> This standard stipulates the definition, requirements of index, food additives, hygienic requirements in processing, marking, packaging, storage, transportation and determination methods of salt and liquor-saturated aquatic product of animal origin. This standard applies to the directly eaten salt & liquor-saturated aquatic products made from live mud snail, river crab, crab, shrimp, seashell and fresh sea crab, which are salted, inebriated, added supplementary materials or not. This standard also applies to aquatic processed products made from fresh shuttle crab, which are cleaned with water, thrown off the crab shell, gill and the end of crab feet, salted and crushed.
