	No international guidelines exist for minimum required performance limits (MRPLs) for malachite green in aquaculture products.
	The Community Reference Laboratory responsible for malachite green analysis (Laboratoire d'études et de recherches sur les médicaments vétérinaires et les désinfectants, AFSSA Fougères (France)) has advised, after discussing with the National References Laboratories in the member States, on the most suitable analytical methods to detect malachite green and its metabolites leucho malachite green, and has proposed a MRPL in aquaculture products.
