- **Description of content:** In order to protect the consumer from dangers of consuming food contaminated with drugs and drug residues, the Ministry of Health Malaysia has been enforcing the ban of the following prohibited drugs in food intended for human consumption since 16 January 1998:
 - (a) Beta-agonists,
 - (b) Nitrofurans and
 - (c) Chloramphenicol.

All imported carcass, meat and edible offal of cattle, pigs, sheep, goat, poultry and their products and fish and fishery products intended for human consumption must be accompanied by a Health Certificate from the competent authority stating the absence of the prohibited drugs and drug residues as follows:

- (a) Beta-agonists in the carcass, meat and edible offal of cattle, pigs, sheep, goat and their products
- (b) Nitrofurans in the carcass, meat and edible offal of poultry and their products, and fish and fishery products
- (c) Chloramphenicol in the carcass, meat and edible offal of poultry and their products, and fish and fishery products
