Description of content: The whole fish, where parasites in viscera have been found and could be totally removed, is sent to processing, under sanitary veterinary surveillance, in an establishment sanitary veterinary approved, that have facilities for efficiently remove the parts with parasites and where the hygiene conditions for avoiding the contamination are fulfilled; the fish where parasites have been found in muscle or in muscle and viscera is declared unfit for human consumption and will not be acceptable for putting on the market, in accordance with the national sanitary veterinary legislation in force.
