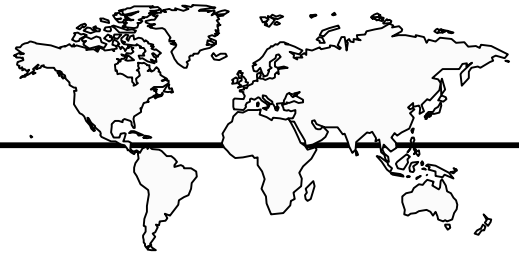


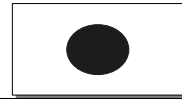

✓ Illustration of most heavily exported items, by value.

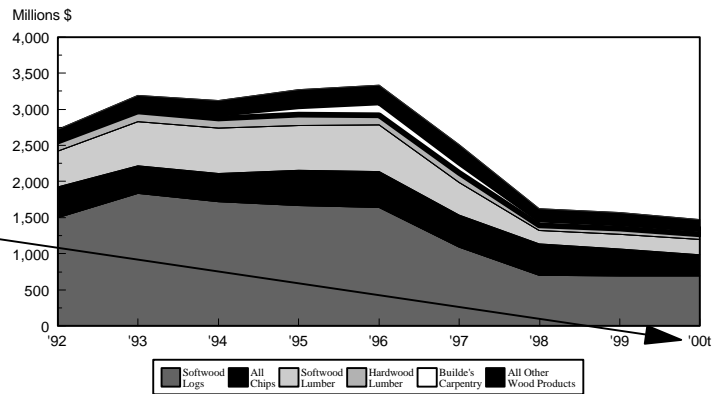
✓ Estimate of the 2000 total based on trend data for 9 months.
