Third Quarter Trade Edition

- Canada is the leading export market for U.S. hardwood lumber.
- The hardwood lumber species imported the most by Canada, in terms of value, are red oak and maple.
- Canada imported almost \$400 million of hardwood lumber from the United States in 2000. U.S. exports to Canada through the third quarter of 2001 were \$262 million, 14 percent lower than the same period in 2000.
