

## EXPLANATORY FOOTNOTES FOR TABLES

- 1/ Trade Account = Exports - Imports. Parentheses indicate negative value.
- 2/ Hardwood and softwood breakdowns are not available before 1989. Both are included as softwood chips prior to 1989.
- 3/ Prior to 1981, this category includes fiberboard with a density equal to or greater than 31 pounds/ft<sup>3</sup>. Beginning with 1989, this category includes fiberboard with a density exceeding 0.8 g/cm<sup>3</sup>.
- 4/ This category was added in 1989 and includes fiberboard with a density exceeding 0.5 g/cm<sup>3</sup> but not exceeding 0.8 g/cm<sup>3</sup>.
- 5/ Other Panel Products includes miscellaneous panel products, such as veneered panels, certain types of particleboard, laminated lumber, insulation board and compound panel products.
- 6/ Miscellaneous wood products include wood waste, pulpwood, building components, containers, and woodenware. Due to the removal of code 9705.00.00090, this category may not agree with prior publications, thus affecting total value of U.S. exports.
- 7/ Builder's Carpentry includes concrete forms, edge-glued lumber, fabricated structural members, flush doors, joinery, other joinery, shingles, shakes, windows, window frames, doors, and door frames.
