- U.S. exports of hardwood lumber have increased for the third year in a row, up by \$72 million in 2000 from the previous year, almost reaching the record set in 1997.
- In terms of volume, exports this year set a record at 2.95 million cubic meters.
- This recovery has been fueled in large part by increased exports to Canada, China, and Spain.
