## U.S. TRADE INTERNET SYSTEM

Exporters now have unlimited access to the most up-to-date trade data on U.S. exports and imports of agricultural, fishery, and forestry products. The U.S. Trade Internet System, developed by the U.S. Department of Agriculture=s Foreign Agricultural Service, incorporates the latest export and import data supplied by the U.S. Census Bureau.

This service allows users the flexibility to customize their data searches and save their search criteria for repeated use. Data can be selected by harmonized code or selected commodity groupings on either a value or volume basis. Users will also be able to track trade trends since the database will include exports and imports going back to 1989.

Foreign Agricultural Service's Production, Supply and Distribution (PS&D) online database is now available. This database contains current and historical official USDA data on production, supply and distribution of agricultural commodities for the United States and key producing and consuming countries. Users may select from a menu of pre-defined tables categorized by commodity or commodity group, or create custom queries for specific commodities, attributes and/or countries. For your convenience, the system enables you to view queried data onscreen or download it as a file that you can open with your spreadsheet or database program.
