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- 1. <u>Policy.</u> Pacific Region (PR) first-order stations (Pago Pago, Majuro, Pohnpei, Chuuk, Yap, and Koror) that use the Microcomputer Aided Paperless Surface Observations (MAPSO) for taking METAR, SPECI, F-6, and SYNOPTIC observations shall follow the procedures listed below for <u>on-station</u> retention and disposition of these observational records:
 - 1.1 In addition to end-of-month records that are sent to NCDC, Retain MAPSO diskettes (copy of NCDC disk) on station for <u>one year</u>. After one year, recycle for future use.
 - 1.2 Retain MAPSO Printouts (hard copy) on station for <u>three months</u>, then dispose of locally. There is <u>no longer</u> a requirement to mail observational records to the University of Hawaii.
