Reimbursable Agreement Number (**RAN**): The RAN is a required part of a reimbursable Accounting String in FPD. It goes in the System Data Field, which is one of the blocks in FPD that appear under the account line. The RAN is the same as the CERCLA case number (CPN) or Disaster case number (DPN). For Cases that extend across Fiscal Years, the RAN is the CPN, with the newer Fiscal Year Appropriation Code added at the end.(Eg: 2005 case C05049 becomes C05049601 in 2006). The system needs an "R" in the front and the "R" should already be in the little window. Enter the CPN or DPN and click the "••••". The same CPN should appear in the window that opens. Select it and accept it. If you get a list of CPNs/DPNs in the selection window, make certain to select the same CPN/DPN as the Program Element.

IMPORTANT

1. FEMA issues Mission Assignments on a Disaster by Disaster, State by State, and ESF by ESF basis. There are also different kinds of mission assignments within an ESF.

DPNs are based specifically on the corresponding FEMA Mission Assignments or related EPA IAGs/EAs providing the funding.

Coast Guard spending must follow the same logic and be documented and billed according to this structure or FEMA will disallow Coast Guard billings for reimbursement. A failure to recover costs would force the Coast Guard to cover the costs out of its own OE Appropriation.

2. ESF-10 DPNS are generated manually by the NPFC Financial Management Division and sent via official USCG message to the Coast Guard unit being assigned the funds. The message identifies the disaster by name, the state, allowed use based on tasking in the mission assignment, and other management information.
