




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Cotton: World Markets and Trade

Changing World Consumption



Consumption of raw cotton continues to move from high labor to low labor rate countries. China and the Asia Sub-Continent have seen the largest growth in cotton consumption due to their low labor rate. Chinese cotton consumption has risen more than 10-percent a year since 2000 with a high of 12.4 percent in 2002/03.

At the same time developed country consumption was flat. The United States has experienced the most dramatic decline in consumption from 10.2 million bales in 1999/00 to 6.2 million bales (39.2 percent decline). Higher labor rates than other cotton producing countries has caused the United States to lose its competitiveness in cotton textile production. The European Union (EU) has also experienced a decline in consumption due to a higher labor costs and unfavorable exchange rate. The generally more efficient Asian countries outside China and the Sub-Continent saw stagnant growth.

Lower prices in recent years have accelerated the shift. In April of 1995 the A-index reached a record level of \$1.19, then began its fall to a twenty year low of \$0.3495 in October of 2001. During this large decline in price cotton consumers in developing countries competitive advantage in cotton textile products was enhanced. Lower labor prices became increasingly important as cotton prices fell, because with a lower cotton price labor rates became a larger portion of the overall cost of production

U.S. COTTON OUTLOOK

2003/04 projections are virtually unchanged this month. Production is estimated at 18.2 million bales, up only 9,000 bales from last month. Domestic mill use, exports, and ending stocks are unchanged.

WORLD COTTON OUTLOOK

China: There were no changes to China this month.

Australia: Australia's 2003/04 exports forecast decreased 50,000 bales in January due to significantly lower marketing year-to-date levels of exports.

Brazil: Brazil's 2003/04-production forecast was increased 200,000 bales in January due a new estimate from CANOB. This increase in supply is expected to help increase Brazil's consumption 100,000 bales over last month's forecast.

Cote d'Ivoire: Post reports increased production 150,000 bales in 2002/03 and 50,000 bales in 2003/04. Exports were increased 50,000 bales in 2002/03 due to the higher production. No changes were made to exports in the current year due to unstable political situation. (<http://www.fas.usda.gov/gainfiles/200312/146085501.pdf>)

Egypt: Egyptian exports decreased due to a new government restrictions on exports. Imports were also reduced due to a global shortage in ELS cotton. (<http://www.fas.usda.gov/gainfiles/200311/146085200.pdf>)

India: India's textile commission released MY 2003/04 data showing India's consumption lower than expected, accordingly consumption was lowered while exports were raised for 2003/04.

Korea: Korean imports fell 50,000 bales due to a decline in year-to-date imports compared to the last few years. The import decline drove consumption down 50,000 bales.

Mexico: Mexico's textile industry has seen stronger than expected growth since the beginning of MY 2003/04 causing consumption to be increased 100,000 bales. With this increase exports were decreased and imports increased by 50,000 bales to make up the difference.

Pakistan: 2003/04 production forecast in Pakistan is down 300,000 bales, due to new ginning data. Other official data showed a consumption of domestic cotton declining and reliance on foreign cotton increasing. Imports were increased 150,000 bales from the December forecast.

Russia: Trailing yarn production data in Russia forced consumption down 50,000 bales, which in turn decreased demand for imports by 50,000 bales.

Taiwan and Thailand: Imports in both countries fell by 50,000 bales due to lower than expected first quarter imports.

COTTON PRICES

The A-Index, a principal measure of international cotton prices, is an average of the five lowest quotes of major cotton growths for delivery to Northern European ports. In December, the index averaged 73.61 cents per pound, down 3.16 cents from November's average of 76.77 cents per pound. In New York, the nearby July futures contract settlement price rose 7.07 cents between the end of November and of December, closing at 56.20 cents per pound on December 31st.

U.S. Highlights

Textile Mill Report: Domestic mill purchases were slow, as reports indicated that buyers were reluctant to buy at the current price levels. Buyers bought a light volume of 2003-crop cotton for December 2003 through March 2004 delivery. A few mills have delayed some of their October deliveries to November. Sales of finished products determined when and how much raw cotton would be bought.

U.S. COTTON EXPORTS totaled \$143.9 million or 482,457 bales in October according to Census data, up from \$99.5 million or 352,935 bales in August. Mexico was the top destination for U.S. cotton in October at 111,928 bales or \$32.6 million, followed by China at 52,747 bales or \$14.5 million.

U.S. COTTON IMPORTS increased to \$3.3 million (8356 bales) in October from \$2.3 million (6141 bales) in September. In October, Egypt accounted for all imports. In

September, Egypt accounted for \$1.9 million (5,215 bales) and Australia accounted for \$446,000 (927 bales).
