Appendix

Notes Regarding Tables I and II

Note 1: (Re: Tables I & II) Data for Table I were run on 6/27/07. Only applications assigned to a program by that date were included. (Seven applications for the October 2007 Council had not been assigned at the time this table was assembled on 8/21/2007.) Applications that had been withdrawn by that date were excluded from Table I. For Table II, run on 8/21/07, only applications that had been assigned to a program, reviewed, and percentiled by that time were included. One grant application in the RPG line did not meet these criteria at the time Table II was prepared.

Note 2: (Re: Table I) Research Program Grant applications shown in the first line include R01 (Research Projects), P01 (Program Projects), R15 (Academic Research Enhancement Awards), R21 (Exploratory/Developmental Awards), R34 (Clinical Trial Planning Grant Awards) and U01 (Cooperative Agreements). Small grant applications (R03) are shown separately on the following line. Contracts are not included. Costs shown are the first year total direct costs requested. Facilities and Administrative costs are not included.

Note 3: (Re: Table I & II) Data include applications to be reviewed by Council, applications considered not competitive and applications requesting \$50,000 or less.

Note 4: (Re: Table I) The data may include competing supplements to existing grants. These supplements are counted as separate applications except in the Center line.

Note 5: (Re: Table II) The data include Research Project Grants that were percentiled in review, excluding R15s. That is why the "number reviewed" in Table II is less than the corresponding number of applications in line 1 of Table I. In addition, applications in response to RFAs are not percentiled. In summary the data in Table II include P01, R01, R03, R21, and U01 applications to NIA for October 2007 Council as long as they are not in response to an RFA and have been percentiled.
