-->As a resident of southern Nevada for a decade and a half I have concerns about the Yucca Mountain project. I am writing today to comment on the proposed Mina Corridor.

Essentially, the Mina Corridor and the DOE proposal to redesign how high-level nuclear waste would be disposed of at Yucca is a complete redo of the nuclear waste program.

There is no safe route to Yucca Mountain. The previous system, via the Caliente corridor, was unsuitable. The Mina route is even worse. The Corridor would affect more people and natural resources than the former Caliente route. There is a huge risk to Nevada's public health and environment from these routes.

The DOE must fully consider the "No Action" alternative. The Mina Corridor is extremely dangerous, has a high degree of uncertainty, and must be removed from consideration.
