

Table 8: U.S. Export Sales Summary ^{1/}

U.S. export sales were down in December 2000. Upland cotton sales for delivery in MY 2000/2001 during Dec 1 - Dec 28 (4 weeks) registered net sales of 407,000 running bales, a weekly average of 101,750 bales. In MY 1999/2000 upland sales during Dec 3 - Dec 30, registered net sales of 737,700 running bales, a weekly average of 184,425 bales. The weekly upland export average through Dec 28 for MY 2000/2001 was 80,000 running bales against MY 1999/2000's weekly export average of 70,000 bales. Accumulated exports through Dec 28 for MY 2000/2001 were 1.8 million running bales, compared with 1.5 million last year. Total upland outstanding sales for MY 2000/2001 were 2.6 million running bales, compared with 3.4 million bales the same time a year ago. Upland commitments to date were 4.4 million running bales, compared with 5 million bales last year. Pima export sales during Dec 1 - Dec 28 for delivery during MY 2000/2001 totaled 15,400 running bales and total net sales were 14,200 bales. Pima accumulated exports through Dec 28 for MY 2000/2001 totaled 168,300 running bales, compared with 91,000 bales the same time a year ago. Total Pima commitments amounted to 383,700 running bales.
