Phase II Data Collection Instruments and Timeline: 54 months of age through 1st grade

Retention of the sample from one month of age through this Phase was excellent; only 261 participants dropped out through Phases I and II. Thus, 1,103 families continued participation through Phase 2.

In the original design of the study, sample size was determined to allow for a significant dropout over the course of the study (originally the first three years of the child's life). The initial sampling plan projected the need for a minimum of 900 subjects to allow a power not less than .85 for the major hypotheses of the study. The high retention rate has resulted in a sample well above the 900 mark even after six years of the Study.

Data collection for the study began in 1991, when participating children were one month old and has continued (in Phases 1 and 2) through the first grade. Over this nearly seven-year period, research assistants from the 10 data collection sites saw each child at home, in child care (if used), in elementary school, and in a laboratory playroom. They also completed telephone updates every three months in Phase 1, and every four months in Phase 2, ending when the child was 54 months of age, with a six-month phone follow-up when the child was 60 months of age.

Researchers assessed the child, the parent(s), and the social and physical characteristics of the home, of the child-care (and after-school) environments, and the elementary school (see Phase I Instruments.pdf for additional information regarding the phase I assessments). The table below outlines the data collection schedule (excluding the regular family phone calls).
