SUBJECT: Adjusted Gross Revenue-Lite (AGR-Lite) Expansion for 2008 Crop Year

BACKGROUND:

The Risk Management Agency (RMA) approved the expansion of the Adjusted Gross Revenue-Lite (AGR-Lite) plan of insurance to the following states beginning with the 2008 insurance year: Alabama, eleven counties in Colorado (all Colorado counties now have AGR-Lite), Florida, Georgia, Hawaii, South Carolina, and Tennessee. AGR-Lite will be available in 35 states for the 2008 insurance year.

AGR-Lite insurance offers producers insurance protection for adjusted whole farm revenue.
