**SUBJECT:** 2008 Crop Year (CY) Additional Price Election for Durum Wheat in  
Arizona and California

The Risk Management Agency (RMA) is providing an additional price election for 2008 CY durum wheat in Arizona and California. The additional price represents the maximum price election for the crop year and is \$5.75 per bushel. This price election is available to all producers of durum wheat in Arizona and California who insure their 2008 crop at levels above catastrophic coverage. Price election choices must be made on or before the sales closing date for the crop in a county.

The price for catastrophic coverage is \$3.17 per bushel for durum wheat in Arizona and California.
