SUBJECT: 2005 Crop Year (CY) Additional Price Election for Flue-Cured and
Burley Types of Tobacco

The Risk Management Agency is providing additional price elections for 2005 CY flue-cured and burley tobacco. The additional price represents the maximum price election for the crop year and is \$1.35 per pound for flue-cured tobacco and \$1.50 per pound for burley tobacco. These price elections are available to all producers of flue-cured and burley tobacco that insure their 2005 crop at levels above catastrophic coverage. Price election choices must be made on or before the sales closing date for the crop in a county.

The price for catastrophic coverage is \$0.75 per pound for flue-cured tobacco and \$0.83 per pound for burley tobacco.
