SUBJECT: 2006 Crop Year (CY) Additional Price Election for Durum Wheat in  
Montana, North Dakota, and South Dakota

The Risk Management Agency (RMA) is providing an additional price election for 2006 CY durum wheat in Montana, North Dakota, and South Dakota. The additional price represents the maximum price election for the crop year and is \$3.22 per bushel. This price election is available to all producers of durum wheat in Montana, North Dakota, and South Dakota who insure their 2006 crop at levels above catastrophic coverage. Price election choices must be made on or before the sales closing date for the crop in a county.

The price for catastrophic coverage is \$1.78 per bushel for durum wheat in Montana, North Dakota, and South Dakota.
