## Job Title: Compliance & Performance Manager - Residential Buildings Energy \$aving Partners Program

The Compliance & Performance Manager is a new position, and will work closely with GEO's E\$P Program Manger in support of Governor Ritter's plan for a New Energy Economy.

The E\$P program provides energy efficiency retrofit resources to more than 20,000 annual lowincome households across Colorado through a network of sub-contractors and partners. The E\$P program has an annual operating budget that exceeds \$15 million, and is comprised of federal, state and utility funding partners, each with specific implementation and reporting requirements. As the E\$P program continues to grow in both size and scope, an opportunity has now arisen for an experienced Compliance & Performance Manager to join the E\$P team.
