

Job Title: Regional Representative - Southern Region

The Governor's Energy Office Regional Representative (GEORR) is the regional field representative for the Governor's Energy Office (GEO). There are four GEORR's, each responsible for a region of the state where they are GEO's primary representative.

This GEORR opening is in a newly created territory that spans southern Colorado from the San Luis Valley to the Four Corners region of the state. (See gray area in the map below.) The applicant must live within the region.



GEORR's are responsible for relationships with communities, identification of community projects and program opportunities, implementation of GEO programs and measurement and verification of GEO's efforts. GEO's programs are focused on providing services to local governments, be they counties or municipalities, but other implementation approaches and agencies should be considered including economic development offices and other civic, environmental or community based groups that could implement GEO's programs.

Required Experience/Capabilities

The applicant must have experience working with governments and communities in an organizational capacity and must be a strong advocate for renewable energy and energy efficiency with a bias towards results and implementing mature technologies focused on saving or producing cost effective energy. A strong working knowledge of solar technologies and an interest in working on those issues in particular is preferred.
