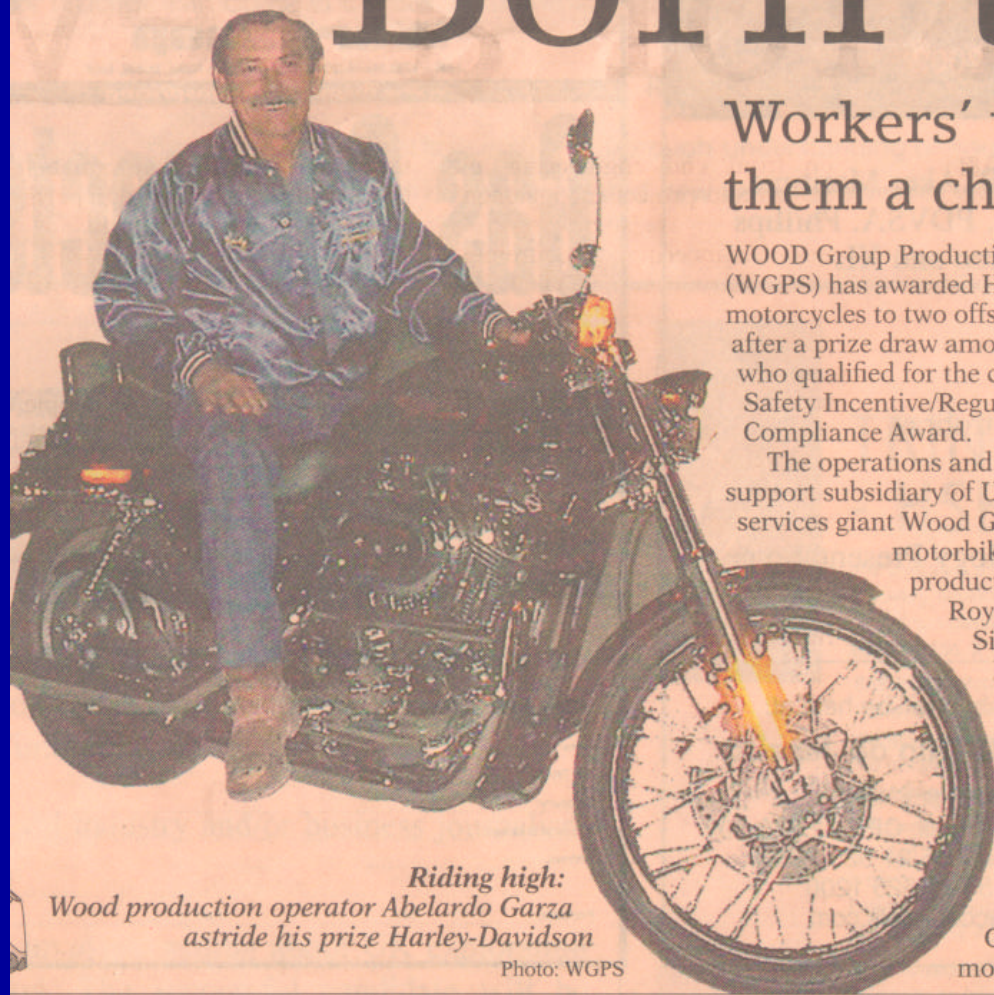
The men were selected from a draw of more than 320 qualified employees.

To qualify for the American classic, one had to: 1) be employed for the full quarter; 2) sustain no lost-time, on-the-job accidents; 3) not violate WGPS or client safety policies; and 4) not directly cause an unauthorised spill.

Employees could also earn bonus entries by complying with Minerals Management Service regulations while at work on offshore platforms.

"The Harley-Davidson prizes generated a great deal of interest and motivated people to work as safely as possible during the past year," said WGPS president David Pilgrim.

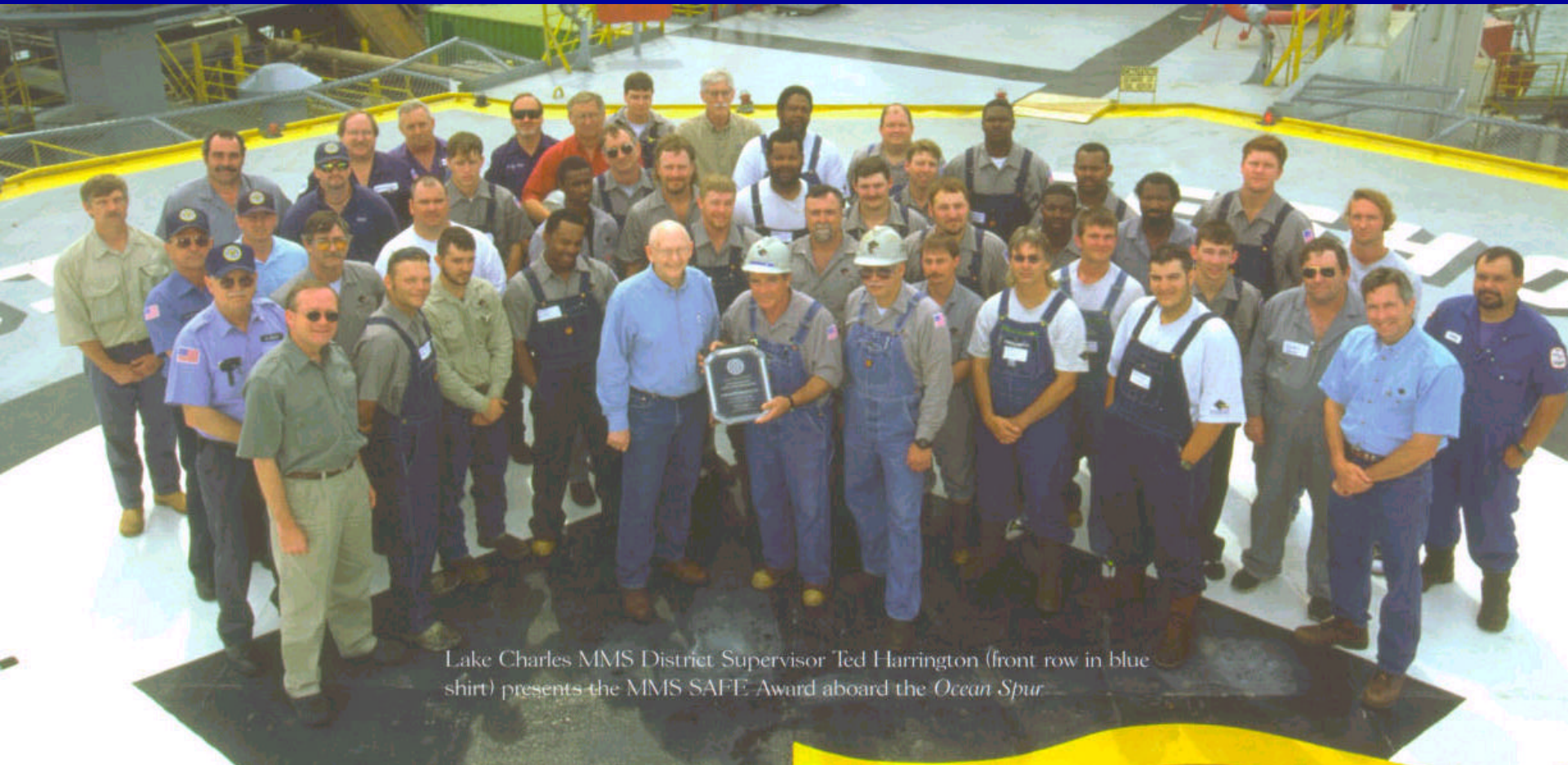

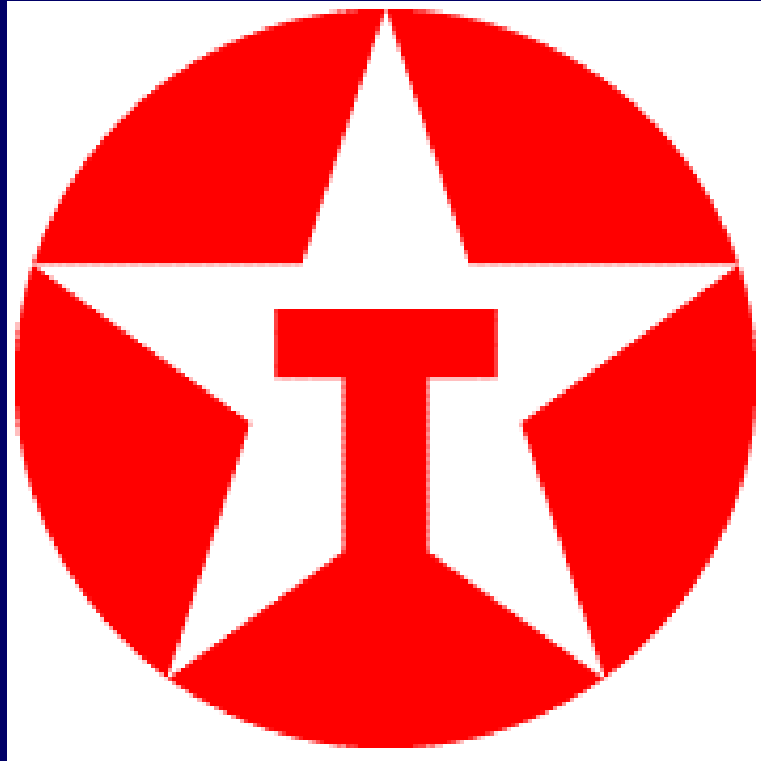
