Travel and Construction Update

UNTIL SEPTEMBER 15:

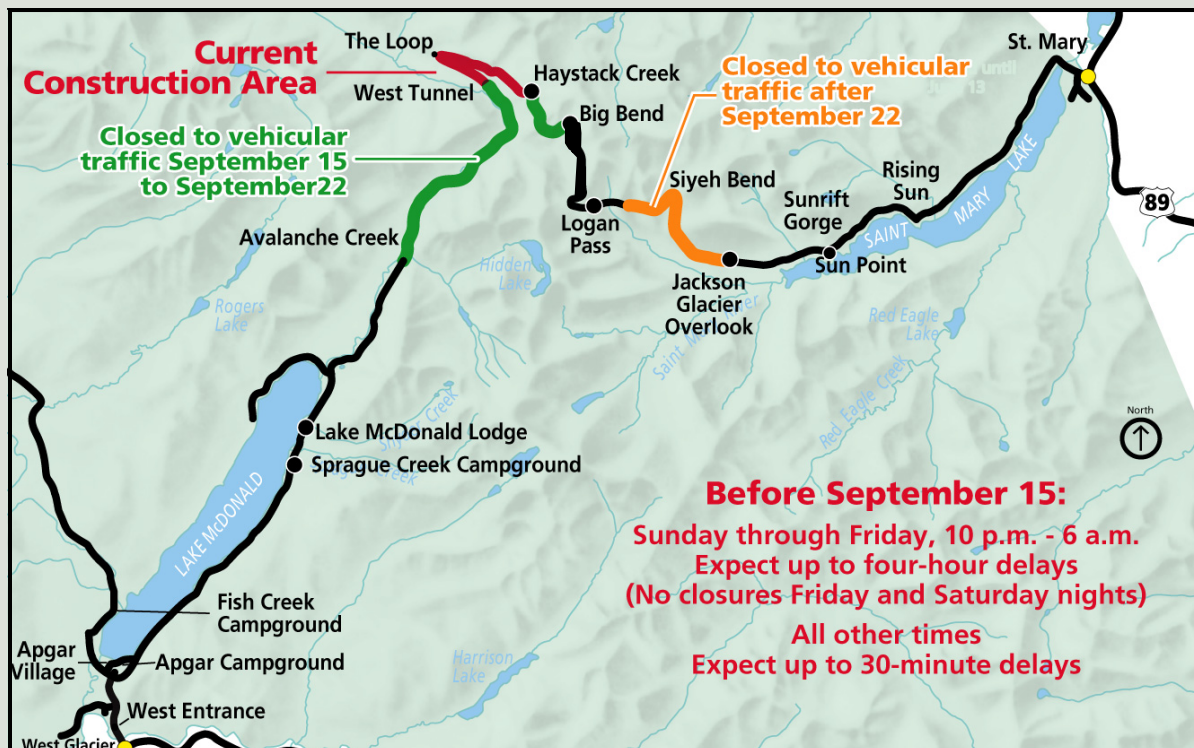
Expect up to four-hour delays during nighttime construction (Sunday night through Friday morning, 10 p.m. to 2 a.m. and 2:30 a.m. to 6 a.m.) on the west side of the road between the West Tunnel and Haystack Creek (3.5 miles). All other times expect one-lane directional travel and a narrow corridor with 30-minute delays.

6 A.M. SEPTEMBER 15 TO 6 A.M. SEPTEMBER 22:

The section of road between Avalanche Creek and Big Bend will be closed to vehicular traffic for paving operations between West Tunnel and Crystal Point. Hiking and biking access will be allowed for 6 miles above Avalanche.

AFTER 6.A.M. SEPTEMBER 22:

The entire road will be open to traffic except for the section between Jackson Glacier Overlook and the east side of Logan Pass while final repairs are done to the 2006 storm-damaged sites below the East Tunnel. Logan Pass will only be accessible from the west side. Hiking and biking access will be allowed for 2 miles above Jackson Glacier Overlook.
