OREGON ENTRY POLICY FOR OVER-DIMENSION LOADS

Motor carriers transporting oversize or overweight loads that originate in Oregon must obtain a variance permit and the driver must possess that permit <u>prior</u> to transport.

Motor carriers entering Oregon with an oversize or overweight load must obtain a variance permit and the driver must possess that permit <u>prior</u> to entering the State *except* as provided in (1), (2) AND (3) below:

(1) Enter Oregon at one of the Entry Points and travel directly to the corresponding ODOT Registration Office shown below.

(2) Arrive during Registration Business Hours: 8AM to 5PM (except Farewell Bend - 7AM to 4PM); Monday through Friday*. *Closed on ALL State Observed Holidays: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. Note: All time is displayed in Pacific Time.

Note: Drivers entering Oregon at <u>any other location</u> must obtain and possess their variance permits prior to entry. Registration services are *not* available at the Cascade Locks, Woodburn, or Klamath Falls scales.

THIS POLICY does <u>not</u> authorize a vehicle to exceed the size or weight limits posted on a highway. Due to road construction or other circumstances, highways may be temporarily closed or restricted to lesser dimensions or weight.
