<b>STORAGE</b>			
A-1	<b>Required BMPs for All Commercial Properties</b>		
A-2	<b>Storage of Liquid Materials in Stationary Tanks</b> This does not include underground tanks or small containers		
A-3	<b>Storage of Any Liquid Materials in Portable Containers</b> Such as drums, buckets, jugs, or barrels		
A-4	<b>Storage of Soil, Sand, and Other Erodible Materials</b> This includes storage of all types of erodible materials		
A-5	<b>Storage of Pesticides and Fertilizers</b> This includes non-liquid pesticides and bags or piles of fertilizer		
A-6	<b>Storage and Treatment of Contaminated Soils</b> This applies to contaminated soils that are excavated and left on site		
A-7	<b>Storage and Processing of Food Items</b> This includes storage of fruits, vegetables, meats, and other foods and processing activities at wineries, fresh and frozen juice makers, and other food and beverage processing operations		
A-8	<b>Storage of Solid Wastes and Food Wastes (Including Cooking Grease)</b> This includes regular garbage and all other discarded non-liquid items		
A-9	<b>Storage of Scrap and Recycling Materials (Including Auto Recycling Facilities)</b> This includes scrapped equipment, metal, empty metal drums, junk appliances and vehicles, and assorted recyclables		
A-10	<b>Treatment, Storage, or Disposal of Dangerous Wastes</b>		
<b>WASHING</b>			
A-11	<b>Cleaning or Washing of Tools and Equipment</b> This includes tools, all types of manufactured equipment components, and work equipment such as lawn mowers and fork lifts		
A-12	<b>Cleaning or Washing of Cooking Equipment</b> This includes vents, filters, pots and pans, grills, and related items		
A-13	<b>Vehicle Washing and Steam Cleaning</b> This covers cleaning and washing at all types of establishments, including fleet vehicle yards, car dealerships, car washes, and maintenance facilities		
A-14	<b>Interior Washing Operations (Including Mobile Contractors)</b> This includes carpet cleaners, upholstery cleaners, and drapery cleaners		
A-15	<b>Pressure Washing of Buildings, Rooftops, and Other Large Objects</b>

A-16	<b>Truck or Rail Loading and Unloading of Liquid Materials</b>		
A-17	<b>Fueling Operations</b> This includes gas stations, mobile fuel trucks, pumps at fleet vehicle yards or shops, and other privately owned pumps		
A-18	<b>Engine Repair and Maintenance</b> This covers oil changes and other handling of engine fluids

<b>TYPE OF ACTIVITY</b>			
A-20	<b>Concrete and Asphalt at Temporary Sites</b> This includes construction sites, remodeling, and driveway and parking lot resurfacing		
A-21	<b>Manufacturing and Post-Processing of Metal Products</b> This includes machining, grinding, soldering, cutting, welding, quenching, rinsing, etc.		
A-22	<b>Painting, Finishing, and Coating of Vehicles, Products, and Equipment</b>		
A-23	<b>Wood Treatment and Preserving</b> This includes small scale contractor operations (such as patio decks) and large scale lumber treatment operations		
A-24	<b>Commercial Composting</b>		
A-25	<b>Chemical Applications-Other than for Landscaping</b> This includes use of algacides, fungicides, pesticides, and rodenticides		
<b>LANDSCAPING</b>			
A-26	<b>Landscaping Activities</b> This includes vegetation removal, herbicide and insecticide application, fertilizer application, gardening, and lawn care		
<b>CONSTRUCTION</b>			
A-27	<b>Clearing, Grading, and Preparation of Land for Small Construction Projects</b>		
A-28	<b>Demolition of Buildings</b>		
A-29	<b>Building Repair, Remodeling, and Construction</b>		
A-30	<b>Boat Building, Maintenance, and Repair</b>		
<b>OTHER</b>			
A-31	<b>Vehicle and Equipment Parking and Storage</b> This includes all types of parking lots (commercial, public, and private), retail/store parking, car dealerships, rental car lots, other fleet vehicle lots, equipment storage and parking areas (such as at equipment rental yards)		
A-32	<b>Sidewalk Maintenance</b> This includes cleaning and deicing		
A-33	<b>Swimming Pool and Spa Cleaning and Maintenance</b> This includes all swimming pools and spas not at a single family residence		
A-34	<b>Keeping Animals in Controlled Areas</b> This includes kennels, rabbit hutches, and similar animal rearing and care		
A-35	<b>Keeping Livestock in Stables, Pens, Pastures or Fields</b> This includes cattle, horses, pigs, sheep, goats, and other hooved animals		
A-36	<b>Logging and Log Yards</b> This applies to Class IV general forest practices only		
A-37	<b>Mining and Quarrying of Sand, Gravel, and Other Materials</b> This covers sand, gravel, minerals, peat, clay, rock, etc. but does not include excavation at construction sites		
A-38	<b>Well and Geotechnical Drilling</b> This includes mechanical drilling and directional drilling for water wells and utilities, environmental protection and monitoring wells, and geotechnical borings		
A-39	<b>Roof Vents and Fugitive Emissions (Including Dust)</b>		
A-40	<b>Street Deicing Operations</b> This includes deicing and anti-icing of streets and highways		
A-41	<b>Wheel Wash and Tire Bath Operations</b>		
A-42	<b>Potable Water Line Flushing or Tank Maintenance</b>		
A-43	<b>Use of Soil Amendments on Construction Sites</b>
