### Reminder to Accurately Flag Delinquent Accounts Screened for Treasury Offset Program (TOP)

### 1 Overview

#### **A** Background

The Debt Collection Improvement Act (DCIA) of 1996 requires that delinquent debtors including borrowers and co-borrowers, be referred to TOP for administrative offset of Federal Government payments. Field Offices must update account flags through the Automated Discrepancy System (ADPS) to accurately reflect the status of delinquent debts and to ensure accurate TOP referrals.

#### **B** Purpose

This notice reminds County Offices to timely and accurately update flags on **direct** borrowers accounts.

# 2 Action

# A County Office Action

County Offices must review:

- FmHA Instruction 1951-S, Exhibit O, Description Flags for Farm Loan Programs (FLP) Accounts, to determine the appropriate flag to place on accounts
- all flagged accounts during the last month of each quarter to determine whether flags need to be changed or removed, according to FmHA Instruction 1951-S, Exhibit O
- flag bankruptcy accounts to ensure that borrowers are **not** erroneously referred to TOP.
- **Note:** If an account is properly flagged Bankruptcy Action Pending, ADPS will generate a programmatic delete code and the borrower will **not** appear on TOP Offset Screen.

## **B** State Office Action

State Office must ensure that County Offices are:

- reviewing flagged accounts
- updating or removing ADPS description flags as account status changes.
