### **Description**

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

#### Service Delivery Area







# Medicaid Long term Care Cost Per Case December, 2002





# Percent of Client Employed Providers with One Plus Years of Service in Local Offices - December, 2002









Oregon's top five error factors from October 2001 through May 2002 are reporting errors in wages and salaries, shelter deductions, standard utility allowance, household composition, and child support.


