

NFA Sponsored Off-Campus 10-Day and 6-Day Programs



WHAT IS IT?

The NFA Sponsored Off-Campus 10-Day and 6-Day Program offers the same 10-day and 6-day courses normally taught at the U.S. Fire Administration's (USFA) National Fire Academy (NFA) located in Emmitsburg, Maryland. The NFA's Training Resources and Data Exchange (TRADE) network, which operates within the 10 Federal Government Regions, provides the structure through which these off-campus programs are offered. The TRADE network comprises the training and education administrators of the 50 State Fire Training systems, and the more than 160 largest local fire departments throughout the United States.

Course delivery sites are chosen by the regional TRADE representatives. NFA provides instructors and all training materials for each course. These courses, as with other NFA courses, have recommended college accreditation through the Americal Council on Education.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Each student will be eligible for a stipend reimbursement up to \$100 for a 6-day course and \$200 for a 10-day course to help offset transportation and lodging expenses. All other costs beyond the stipend are the responsibility of the student or his/her sponsoring agency.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

All fire and rescue service personnel who meet the established student selection criteria for the course for which they are interested are eligible to apply.
