Subject: USAID Policy Guidance on Posting Grant Opportunities and Application Packages on Grants.gov

As of December 19, 2005, grant and cooperative agreement Request for Application (RFA) and Annual Program Statement (APS) announcements, modifications to the announcements, and the corresponding application packages must be posted to Grants.gov to allow for electronic submission of applications. The exceptions to this are:

1. Programs that only publish funding opportunities in the Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA).
2. Announcements of funding opportunities for awards less than \$25,000, for which 100 percent of eligible applicants live outside the United States.
3. Single (sole) source announcement of funding opportunities issued by an agency, which are specifically directed to a known recipient.

The attachment contains specific guidance for creating and posting application packages in Grants.gov.
