Location: Public lands adjacent to Natural Bridges National Monument, approximately 38 miles west of Blanding.


Implementation Date: Work began on during the winter of 06/07. Remaining units will be completed in 2008.

Project Description:

Four separate units have been identified for treatment adjacent to the Natural Bridges National Monument. Treatments planned and completed include; thinning, piling, pile burning and bullhog. Treatments in these old growth pinyon/juniper and sage brush flats are designed to reduce invasive pinyon and juniper trees and the restoration of degraded ecosystems. Goals for this project



include: improved public and fire fighter safety, a reduction in invasive species and hazardous fuels and improved structure protection for the Natural Bridges National Monument.
