

Project Description: The overall goals of this fuels management project are the prevention of standreplacement wildland fires and the protection of the health and safety of public and firefighters. Treatment objectives include: thinning coniferous trees and brush to a more natural and historic density, reducing fuels loads, limiting the growth and spread of gamble oak in the campground and along the road, enhancing wildlife habitat by reducing slash,



brush and other understory vegetation in old growth ponderosa pine stands, and the reintroduction of fire into the ecosystem to sustain a healthy ponderosa pine forest.
