## **Background**

USDA continues to explore various disposal options for the CCC-owned inventory. Commencing in June 2001, Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC) will, at the option of the storing sugar processor, make the monthly storage payments on CCC-owned sugar in kind. The following information is being provided to address potential questions.

## Invoice Changes as of June 1, 2001 (i.e. May storage charges)

- Warehouse operators will have the option to select either the traditional monetary payment via electronic fund transfer or a sugar payment in kind.
- The invoices will contain an option to select a dollar payment or pound equivalent payment.
- Failure to select an option will result in a monetary payment.
- Market prices used in determining the dollar equivalent amount of sugar will be determined by CCC.
- Sugar taken in payment will be released basis bulk, instore.
- Only CCC-owned sugar recorded at the warehouse listed on the invoice will be released under the payment in kind option.
- The stop storage date for sugar released instore will be the earlier of either the date of release or the 15th day of the month.
