Background

The Kansas City Commodity Office continues to receive warehouse receipts for forfeited commodities that contain incorrect or incomplete information.

Warehouse Receipt Requirements

Warehouse receipts **must** be issued in accordance with the procedures outlined in the Warehouse Operator's Handbook, Part 2, Section 1, Par. 23, Pages 2-5 thru 2-9. Please review and comply with these requirements. In addition to these requirements, please note the following:

The protein percentage for all Hard Red Spring, Hard Red Winter, and Hard White wheat classes is required, according to the UGRSA.

Starting immediately for all crop years:

- Warehouse receipts for all subclasses of Durum must contain the percentage of hard and vitreous kernels of amber color.
- Warehouse receipts for all Durum, Hard Red Spring, and Soft Red Winter wheat must contain the falling number.
