- Develop and maintain relationships with advocacy groups, organizations and agencies that facilitate the employment of people with disabilities.
- Develop resources for businesses to support the employment of people with disabilities.
- Link jobseekers with disabilities to Career Solutions Center counselors for services that will support them in meeting employment goals.
- Provide information to people with disabilities regarding how earnings affect their Social Security benefits and other support programs: Ticket to Work, Medicaid Purchase Plan, and Benefits Planning Services.
- Provide information to Career Solutions Centers about programs, services, housing and transportation supports as they impact the search for employment.
