## RE: Children's Mental Health System Change Initiative Policy Six – Financing Updated

The Office of Mental Health and Addiction Services (OMHAS) has updated the Children's System Change Initiative (CSCI) Policy Six regarding financing. OMHAS distributed a series of policy statements in September 2004 that provided guidance for CSCI implementation.

The Financing Policy has been updated to reflect the operational methodology that went into effect on October 1, 2005. Prior to implementation these changes received input from the Children's System Advisory Committee, Mental Health Organizations, provider groups, the Department of Human Services (DHS) Actuarial Services, and the DHS contract actuary firm.

Changes to the Financing Policy are in bold type and reflect modifications in the financing and infrastructure stabilization glide path dates and percentages, the rate setting percentages and dates for Psychiatric Residential and Psychiatric Day Treatment Services, and Long Term Psychiatric Care Services.
