I. CASE SYNOPSIS.

A. ON AUGUST 19, 2002, CHILD PROTECTIVE SERVICES (CPS) RECEIVED A REPORT OF ALLEGED PHYSICAL NEGLECT OF THEN SEVEN MONTH OLD RONELA B. PASCUAL, BY HER MOTHER, DELA A. PASCUAL. DR. JOHNS, PSYCHIATRIC CONSULTANT FROM KAPIOLANI MEDICAL CENTER REPORTED THAT AT BIRTH, RONELA WAS IN THE 75 TH PERCENTILE FOR WEIGHT ON THE GROWTH CHART. ON JULY 26, 2002, RONELA'S FIRST HOSPITALIZATION HER WEIGHT DROPPED BELOW THE 5TH PERCENTILE FOR WEIGHT. MRS. PASCUAL CLAIMED THAT RONELA WAS REFUSING TO TAKE BOTTLES AND WOULD ONLY WANT TO BE BREAST FEED. DR. ALLAN IKEDA, PEDIATRIC INTERN AKSI STATED THAT MRS. PASCUAL GIVING RONELA STRANGE FOODS SUCH AS "CHEETOS." RONELA'S CONDTION WAS MONITORED AND SUBSEQUENTLY RELEASED TO HER MOTHER WITH THE FOLLOWING RECOMMENDATIONS: 1). MOTHER TO ENGAGE IN SERVICES VIA. KAPIOLANI COUNSELING CENTER, 2). AND "0 TO 3"SERVICES FOR RONELA.

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NARRATIVE ACCOUNT

ON AUGUST 13, 2002, RONELA WAS HOSPITALIZED FOR A SECOND TIME AS HER WEIGHT DROPPED BELOW THE 3RD PERCENTILE FOR WEIGHT. MRS. PASCUAL REPORTED THAT RONELA CONTINUES TO REFUSE BOTTLES. THUS, SHE WAS BREAST FEEDING ALONG WITH SUPPLEMENTAL FOODS. KMC STAFF ATTEMPTED TO BOTTLE FEED AND RONELA INDEED REFUSED. CONSEQUENTLY, RONELA WAS PUT ON AN "IV" FOR NUTRITION AND SHE IMMEDIATELU GAINED WEIGHT. IN ADDITION, MRS. PASCUAL FAILED TO COMPLY WITH KMC' RECOMMENDED SERVICES

ON AUGUST 27, 2002, DR. VICTORIA SCHNEIDER, PEDIATRIC CONSULTANT OF THE CPS TEAM ASSESSED RONELA'S CONDITION AS BEING "NON-ORGANIC FAILURE TO THRIVE."

INITIALLY, THE FSA HAD DIFFICULTY SCHEDULING A HOME VISIT. THE FSA LEFT

SEVERAL VOICEMAIL MESSAGES FROM AUGUST 28 THROUGH AUGUST 30, 2002 FOR MRS. PASCUAL TO RETURN FSA'S CALL TO SET UP A HOME VISIT. SINCE MRS. PASCUAL DID NOT RESPOND TO THE PHONE MESSAGES, THE FSA AND HER SUPERVISOR,

DECIDED TO DO AN UNANNOUNCED VISIT ON AUGUST 30, 2002. AT THIS VISIT, THE FSA AND RAN INTO THE OWNER AND LANDLADY OF THE HOME, , WHO WAS GARDENING. INFORMED THE FSA AND

THAT MRS. PASCUAL WAS PROBABLY HOME WITH RONELA AND THEY WERE BOTH SOUND ASLEEP. SUGGESTED THAT AND THE FSA POUND THE FRONT DOOR OF THE HOME SINCE MRS. PASCUAL IS A VERY SOUND SLEEPER.

THE FSA AND CALLED OUT MRS. PASCUAL'S NAME AND POUNDED ON THE FRONT DOOR INTERMITTENTLY FOR ABOUT TEN TO FIFTEEN MINUTES WITHOUT ANY RESPONSE. MRS. PASCUAL THEN CAME TO THE FRONT DOOR ABOUT FIVE MINUTES LATER AND SHE NOTED SHE JUST WOKE UP. THE FSA QUERIED MRS. PASCUAL IF

THE FSA ASKED MRS. PASCUAL AS TO WHERE RONELA SLEPT. MRS. PASCUAL SHOWED
THE FSA AND THE BEDROOM WHERE TWO FULL SIZED BEDS WERE JOINED
TOGETHER. MRS. PASCUAL REPORTED THAT HER MOTHER, HER BOYFRIEND, SHE AND
RONELA SLEPT ON THE ADJOINED BEDS. SHE FURTHER REPORTED THAT RONELA SLEPT
NEXT TO HER AND NEAR THE WALL.

THE FSA AND EMPHASIZED THAT CHILD SHOULD SLEEP IN THE PLAYPEN
RATHER THAN ON THE BED AS RONELA COULD BE SUFFOCATED OR BE SMOTHERED,
ESPECIALLY IF MRS. PASCUAL IS A SOUND SLEEPER. AND THE FSA
SUGGESTED TO MRS. PASCUAL THAT RONELA SLEEP IN THE PLAYPEN THAT WAS
LOCATED IN THE LIVING ROOM AND THAT SHE SLEEP ALSO IN THE LIVING ROOM WITH

RONELA.

ACCORDING TO MRS. PASCUAL, HER STEPFATHER IS IN CHARGE OF FINANCES AS WELL AS HOUSEHOLD MATTERS. THEREFORE, [REDACTED] CONTACTED [REDACTED], WHO SPEAKS AND UNDERSTANDS ENGLISH, ON HIS CELLULAR PHONE AND EXPLAINED TO HIM ABOUT THE IMPORTANCE OF HAVING RONELA SLEEP IN THE PLAYPEN FOR HER SAFETY RATHER THAN WITH THEM ON THE BED AND THAT MRS. PASCUAL SLEEP ALONGSIDE THE PLAYPEN IN THE LIVING ROOM. ACCORDING TO [REDACTED] SOUNDED VERY COOPERATIVE ON THE PHONE AND UNDERSTOOD THE SAFETY CONCERN. ON THE FOLLOWING VISITS, MRS. PASCUAL, [REDACTED] AND [REDACTED] ASSURED THE FSA THAT RONELA SLEPT IN THE PLAYPEN AND THAT SHE SLEPT ALONGSIDE THE PLAYPEN IN THE LIVING ROOM.

DURING THE VISIT OF SEPTEMBER 18, 2002, WHILE THE FSA WAS ASSISTING MRS.

PASCUAL IN COMPLETING A DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICES, SECTION 8 APPLICATION, SHE NOTICED MRS. PASCUAL HAVING MUCH DIFFICULTY IN SPELLING WORDS AS DAUGHTER, DEL MONTE, AIKAHI LANDSCAPING, AND LISTING THE HEALTH INSURANCE NUMBER ON THE PAPERWORK. THE FSA ALSO HELPED MRS. PASCUAL WITH A STATE OF HAWAII HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC HOUSING.

AT ONE POINT, THE FSA AND [REDACTED] OVERHEARD RONELA MAKING GURGLING NOISES AS IF CHOKING WHILE SHE WAS IN THE PLAYPEN. SECONDS LATER, RONELA VOMITED WHAT SEEMED TO BE FORMULA. MRS. PASCUAL DID NOT RESPOND TO RONELA'S SITUATION, AND THEREFORE, THE FSA AND [REDACTED] EXAMINED RONELA. THE FSA AND [REDACTED] DISCOVERED RONELA HAD CHOKED ON SMALL BROWNISH PIECES OF WHAT LOOKED LIKE TORN PORTIONS OF A NAPKIN. AFTER LOOKING CLOSER AT THE PLAYPEN, THE FSA AND [REDACTED] DISCOVERED THERE

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NARRATIVE ACCOUNT

WAS A NAPKIN TORN IN PIECES. SINCE MRS. PASCUAL SEEMED TO IGNORE RONELA'S DISTRESS, THE FSA AND IMMEDIATELY ASKED MRS. PASCUAL TO CLEAN UP RONELA AND CHANGE HER CLOTHING. MINUTES LATER, MRS. PASCUAL GOT UP TOOK CARE OF RONELA, WITH INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE FSA AND THE FSA REVIEWED INFORMATION ON CHILD SAFETY WITH MRS. PASCUAL AND EMPHASIZED TO MRS. PASCUAL THAT SHE ALWAYS NEEDS TO CHECK THE PLAYPEN FOR ANY DANGEROUS OBJECTS BEFORE PLACING RONELA INTO IT.

THE FSA SHARED INFORMATION OF BASIC INFANT CARE WITH MRS. PASCUAL ON OCTOBER 23, 2002 VISIT. MRS. PASCUAL WAS ASKED TO DEMONSTRATE HOW SHE BATHES RONELA. MRS. PASCUAL FILLED UP A SMALL SQUARE PLASTIC CONTAINER WITH WATER. THE CONTAINER SEEMED TO BE ABOUT TWELVE INCHES BY TWELVE INCHES AND ABOUT EIGHT INCHES IN HEIGHT. WHEN THE FSA FELT THE WATER TEMPERATURE, IT SEEMED QUITE COLD. MRS. PASCUAL REMARKED SOMETIMES THE

WATER TEMPERATURE OF THE WATER HEATER IS HOT BUT MOST OFTEN, COLD.

MRS. PASCUAL THEN PLACED RONELA INTO AN EMPTY INFANT TUB WITH NO WATER AND STARTED TO WASH HER DOWN WITH A WASHCLOTH AND SOAP. AS FOR THE OTHER CONTAINER OF WATER, MRS. PASCUAL TOOK A SMALL CUP AND STARTED POURING IT OVER RONELA IN THE INFANT TUB. THE FSA SUGGESTED MRS. PASCUAL POUR WATER INTO THE INFANT TUB FIRST THEN PLACE RONELA INTO IT TO PREVENT HER FROM BEING COLD. THE FSA NOTICED RONELA WAS FINE, SMILING AND NOT EVEN FLINCHING OR SQUIRMING ABOUT THE COLD WATER TEMPERATURE. LATER THE FSA ASKED TO ASK THE LANDLORD TO MAKE ADJUSTMENTS ON THERMOSTAT ON THE HEATER, BUT HE REFUSED. EXPLAINED THAT HE DID NOT WANT TO MAKE WAVES SINCE THE LANDLORD DID NOT WANT TO RENT TO HIS FAMILY IN THE FIRST PLACE.

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NARRATIVE ACCOUNT

DURING THE PAST FOUR MONTHS OR SO, THE FSA AND HAD ONGOING CONCERNS ABOUT WHAT EXACTLY RONELA WAS BEING FED AND THE AMOUNT BEING FED. THE FSA AND THE PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE, DIANE TAKUMUNE, ASKED MRS. PASCUAL TO RECORD RONELA'S FEEDINGS AND AMOUNT FED INTO THE FOOD DIARY. THE FSA AND THE PHN NOTICED THAT THE DOCUMENTATIONS IN JOURNALS WERE NOT KEPT UP. ON FREQUENT OCCASIONS, THERE WERE NO DOCUMENTATIONS FOR A WEEK OR MORE. MRS. PASCUAL WAS NOT RECORDING THE TABLE FOOD SHE WAS FEEDING RONELA. MRS. PASCUAL WOULD ALSO OFTEN REPORT TO THE FSA THAT RONELA WOULD ONLY EAT "TWO TO THREE TEASPOONS" OF FOOD IN A MEALTIME. AS A RESULT, THE FSA AND BEGAN TO DO MORE FREQUENT VISITS, SCHEDULED AND UNANNOUNCED. ACCORDING TO MRS. PASCUAL, IN RONELA'S MOST RECENT VISIT WITH DR. DANILO S. PERLAS, SHE WEIGHED SEVENTEEN POUNDS, TWO OUNCES.

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NARRATIVE ACCOUNT

ON DECEMBER 3, 2002 AT AROUND 10:40 A.M., FSA 1 AND FSA
MADE AN UNANNOUNCED VISIT TO MRS. PASCUAL'S HOME. WHEN THE
FSA'S ARRIVED, WAS LAYING ON THE LIVING ROOM FLOOR UNDER
HIS BLANKETS. SEEMED TO BE SUPERVISING RONELA ON THE
LIVING ROOM FLOOR SINCE IT WAS HIS SCHEDULED DAY OFF. WHEN FSA
ASKED FOR MRS. PASCUAL'S WHEREABOUTS, MOTHER'S BROTHER,
REMARKED SHE WAS ASLEEP IN THE BEDROOM. THE FSA WOKE UP MRS. PASCUAL IN
THE BEDROOM AND SHE REMARKED SHE WAS NOT SLEEPING BUT RESTING SINCE THE
WEATHER WAS COLD THAT DAY. THE FSA ASKED MRS. PASCUAL IF SHE HAD FED
RONELA AND SHE REPLIED, "YES." THE FSA ASKED MRS. PASCUAL TO IDENTIFY THE
CONTAINER SHE USED TO FEED RONELA AND SHE REMARKED SHE WASHED AND PUT IT
AWAY. THE FSA THEN ASKED IF HE SAW MRS. PASCUAL FEED RONELA
BREAKFAST EARLIER THAT DAY AND HE REPLIED, "YES."

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NARRATIVE ACCOUNT

THE FSA NOTICED RONELA'S FRONT PORTION OF HER DISPOSABLE DIAPER PROTRUDING AS IF QUITE EXPANDED AND FULL. THE FSA ALSO SAW THE DIAPER TO BE QUITE YELLOWISH IN COLOR IN THE FRONT AND BACK PORTIONS. THE FSA IDENTIFIED THIS TO MRS. PASCUAL AND ASKED THAT SHE CHANGE RONELA. MRS. PASCUAL MANAGED TO GET HOLD OF THE DISPOSABLE WIPES. INSTEAD, THE FSA RECOMMENDED MRS. PASCUAL PUT THE WIPES AWAY AND USE SOAP AND WATER TO WASH DOWN RONELA'S DIAPER AREA. WHEN MRS. PASCUAL REMOVED THE SOILED DIAPER, IT FELT QUITE HEAVY TO THE TOUCH. PER MRS. PASCUAL, SHE REMARKED SHE HAD CHANGED RONELA'S DIAPER WHEN CHILD WOKE UP AROUND 7:00 A.M. THAT MORNING.
